PURSUANT to section 120 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Developing countries—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by adding to Part A the item “Zimbabwe”.
