ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of July 1985

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 120 (3) of the Customs Act 1966 (as amended by section 5 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1977, and further amended by section 5 (3) of the Customs Acts Amendment Act (No. 2) 1980), His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Confirmation of extension of Developing Countries Preference to Hungary—The addition to Part A of the Schedule to the principal order of the item "Hungary" (which addition was effected by clause 2 (2) of the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976, Amendment No. 5 and which

came into force on the 1st day of July 1985) is hereby confirmed notwithstanding that clause 2 (2) was accidentally omitted from the published copy of the Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976, Amendment No. 5.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The Developing Countries Tariff Order 1976, Amendment No. 5 came into force on 1 July 1985. Clause 2 (2) of that order which extended the Developing Countries Preference to Hungary, was accidentally omitted from the published copy of that order. The amendment effected by clause 2 (2) of that order is confirmed by this order.

Clause 2 (2) of that order, which was contained in the copy of the order signed by the Governor-General, is in the following terms:

(2) The Schedule to the principal order is hereby further amended by adding to Part A the item "Hungary".
