THE DANGEROUS DRUGS AMENDING REGULATIONS 1947

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 20th day of
August, 1947

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the provisions of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1927, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs Amending Regulations 1947.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Dangerous Drugs Regulations 1928* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1947.

4. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By adding to clause (1) thereof the following paragraph :—

“(g) Where the drug is supplied or dispensed pursuant to an order for group supply of pharmaceutical requirements in bulk to a licensed hospital issued by a medical practitioner under the provisions of the drug tariff as defined by clause 2 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941† as amended by clause 2 of the Social Security (Pharmaceutical Supplies) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 4‡”

(b) By adding to clause (5) thereof the following paragraph :—

“(f) He proves that the drug was supplied to him pursuant to paragraph (g) of clause (1) of this regulation.”
