THE DENTISTS EMPLOYMENT ORDER 1943

Pursuant to Regulation 27 of the Industrial Man-power Emergency Regulations 1942,* the Minister of Industrial Man-power doth hereby order and direct as follows:—

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Dentists Employment Order

1943.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 9th day of September, 1943.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

2. This Order shall apply with respect to all persons who, on the commencement thereof, are registered as dentists under the Dentists Act, 1936, or are holders of provisional practising certificates issued under section 25 of that Act, and who are then engaged in the practice of dentistry within the meaning of that Act, whether on their own account or in partnership with any other person or persons, or as servants or agents of any person, or as members of any company lawfully carrying on the business of dentistry in accordance with section 28 of the said Act.

Obligations of Persons to whom this Order applies

3. (1) Except as provided in the next succeeding subclause, every person to whom this Order applies shall, while this Order remains in force, continue the practice of dentistry in the same place or places and in the same capacity as on the commencement of this Order.

(2) Any person to whom this Order applies may, with the consent

of the District Man-power Officer but not otherwise,—

(a) Cease the practice of dentistry, either wholly or in any specified

place or specified places; or

(b) Continue the practice of dentistry in a capacity different from the capacity in which he is practising at the commencement of this Order; or

(c) Commence the practice of dentistry at any other specified place

or specified places.

DIRECTION TO EMPLOYERS OF DENTISTS

4. No person by whom any dentist is employed as such on the commencement of this Order shall, without the consent of the District Man-power Officer, terminate the employment or so alter the conditions thereof as to prevent or interfere with the carrying-out by such dentist of the obligations imposed on him by the foregoing provisions of this Order.
