**THE DAIRY-PRODUCE EXPORT PRICES ORDER, 1937.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Primary
Products Marketing Act, 1936.

Date on which the regulations were made : 29th day of July, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 5th day of August, 1937.

O R D E R.

1. This Order may be cited as the Dairy-produce Export Prices Order, 1937.

2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 1937.

3. Subject to any further provision hereafter made, the prices to be paid in respect of dairy-produce exported after the 31st day of July, 1937, shall be the prices fixed by the Dairy-produce Export Prices Order, 1936,* as varied by this Order.

4. Clause 5 of the Dairy-produce Export Prices Order, 1936 (as revoked and replaced by clause 2 of the Dairy-produce Export Prices Order, 1936, Amendment No. 1†), is revoked, and the following clause substituted :—

“ 5. The appropriate price payable by the Crown pursuant to clause 3 hereof in respect of any butter to which that clause applies is hereby varied as follows :—

“(a) By payment of the further sum of one farthing per pound in respect of unsalted butter which is manufactured by any manufacturer at the request in writing of the Department, and in such quantity as is from time to time specified in any such request :

“(b) By payment of the further sum of one thirty-second of a penny per pound in respect of unsalted butter which is manufactured as aforesaid and which is properly wrapped as prescribed by paragraph (b) of subclause (2) of clause 79 of the Dairy Regulations‡ and which is packed in a box of any type prescribed by the Dairy Regulations other than the following—namely, a Saranac wire-bound box, the thickness of timber of which is less than $\frac{3}{8}$ in. :

“ Provided that the price of any unsalted butter may be varied both under paragraph (a) and under paragraph (b) of this clause.”

5. The Dairy-produce Export Prices Order, 1936, Amendment No. 1, is revoked as from the date of the coming into force of this order.
