



**THE DAIRY-PRODUCE EXPORT PRICES ORDER 1939,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 17th day of  
February, 1943.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

**ORDER.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Dairy-produce Export Prices Order 1939, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy-produce Export Prices Order 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

**APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER.**

2. This Order shall apply to all creamery butter and to all cheese which, being manufactured from milk or cream delivered to a dairy factory after the 31st day of July, 1942, has heretofore been or is hereafter exported from New Zealand with the concurrence of the Department.

**FIXING PRICES TO BE PAID FOR DAIRY-PRODUCE TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES.**

3. With respect to creamery butter to which this Order applies, clause 3 of the principal Order shall be read as if subparagraphs (i) to (v) of paragraph (a) hereof had been revoked, and as if the following subparagraphs had been substituted therefor:—

- “(i) For ‘Finest’ grade, 94 points or over, 15·515d. per pound.
- “(ii) For ‘Finest’ grade, 93 points or over but under 94 points, 15·39d. per pound.
- “(iii) For ‘First’ grade, 92 points or over but under 93 points, 15·3275d. per pound.
- “(iv) For ‘First’ grade, 90 points or over but under 92 points, 15·14d. per pound.
- “(v) For ‘Second’ grade, 14·64d. per pound.”

4. With respect to cheese to which this Order applies, clause 4 of the principal Order shall be read as if paragraphs (a) to (e) thereof had been revoked, and as if the following paragraphs had been substituted therefor :—

- “(a) For ‘Finest’ grade, 94 points or over, 8·88625d. per pound.
- “(b) For ‘Finest’ grade, 93 points or over but under 94 points, 8·855d. per pound.
- “(c) For ‘First’ grade, 92 points or over but under 93 points, 8·73d. per pound.
- “(d) For ‘First’ grade, 91 points or over but under 92 points, 8·6675d. per pound.
- “(e) For ‘Second’ grade, 8·48d. per pound.”
