## THE DEBTORS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 28th day of April, 1943.

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Debtors Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Debtors Emergency Regulations 1940\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :-

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) of clause (2) the words "a judgment or order for possession of any tenement obtained against any person on the ground that he is a trespasser or that his tenancy has expired ", and substituting the words " an order for the possession of a dwellinghouse to which the Fair Rents Act, 1936, for the time being applies, or for the ejectment of the tenant therefrom ":
- (b) By adding to paragraph (i) of clause (2) the words " not being a lease of a dwellinghouse to which the Fair Rents Act, 1936, for the time being applies ".
