



**THE DEBTORS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 28th day of
April, 1943.

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Debtors Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Debtors Emergency Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) of clause (2) the words “ a judgment or order for possession of any tenement obtained against any person on the ground that he is a trespasser or that his tenancy has expired ”, and substituting the words “ an order for the possession of a dwellinghouse to which the Fair Rents Act, 1936, for the time being applies, or for the ejectment of the tenant therefrom ” :
- (b) By adding to paragraph (i) of clause (2) the words “ not being a lease of a dwellinghouse to which the Fair Rents Act, 1936, for the time being applies ”.
