

## THE DEFENCE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1941 AMENDMENT NO. 6

# C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 31st day of March, 1943.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Part II of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding, after Regulation 17, the following regulation:—
- "17a. (1) The Army Board may from time to time by order authorize the temporary employment of members of the Defence Forces—
  - "(a) In agricultural work; or
  - "(b) In any work that may be declared by the order to be urgent work of national importance.
- "(2) At all times while any such order continues in force it shall be the duty of every member of the Defence Forces to obey any command given by his superior officer in relation to any employment to which the order relates, and every such command shall be deemed to be a lawful command within the meaning of the Army Act.
- "(3) Any such order may at any time be revoked wholly or partly by a subsequent order."
