HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting the figure "7" in paragraph (a) after the word "Sections".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

1. Regulation 17 of the principal regulations suspended (*inter alia*) the operation of sections 25, 41, 42, and 45 of the Defence Act, 1909.

2. The effect of these regulations is to suspend also the operation of section 7 of that Act, which prohibits the enlistment of aliens in the Military Forces.
