HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Subclause (1) of Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the proviso the words "or to the delivery of any commodity to any vendor who purchases the same for the purposes of his business".
- 3. Subclause (2) of Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting "£10", and substituting "£50".
