



**THE DELIVERY EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 3rd day of
February, 1943.

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Clause 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall specify the names and addresses of the vendors who are parties to the scheme."

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 9, the following regulation :—

"9A. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any scheme under these regulations, the committee appointed to assist in the administration of the scheme or, if no committee has been appointed, a Zoning Officer may approve of the delivery of the commodity to which the scheme relates to aged or infirm persons in a manner not provided by the scheme.

"(2) Any such approval may be subject to such conditions as the committee or, as the case may be, the Zoning Officer thinks fit, and may at any time be amended or revoked.

"(3) Nothing in the principal regulations shall apply to any delivery made pursuant to an approval given under this regulation and in accordance with any conditions contained in the approval."

4. The provisions of the principal regulations with respect to the appointment of Zoning Officers or other persons shall have, and be deemed at all times heretofore to have had, effect according to their tenor, notwithstanding anything in subsection (3) of section 60 of the Public Service Act, 1912†.
