ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of November, 1943

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after

Regulation 6, the following new regulation:

"6A. (1) For the purpose of meeting the expenses of any committee in the exercise of its functions in relation to any scheme, the committee may, with the written approval of the Minister, fix a charge or impose a levy to be payable by any vendor who is for the time being a party to the scheme.

"(2) The amount payable and the method of assessment of any payments under this regulation shall be such as are approved by the

Minister.

"(3) Any payment due under this regulation may be recovered in any Court of competent jurisdiction by any person appointed in writing for that purpose by the committee to which the amount is payable.

"(4) Any committee may remit or refund the whole or any part of any charge or levy fixed or imposed by it under this regulation."
