THE DEPENDENCY EMERGENCY REGULATIONS (NO. 2) 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 17th day of January, 1940.

Pursuant to the Cook Islands Act, 1915, and the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Dependency Emergency Regulations (No. 2) 1939, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Dependency Emergency Regulations (No. 2) 1939,* and those regulations shall apply to the regulations the short titles of which are set out in the Schedule hereto.
- 3. These regulations shall come into force in the Cook Islands other than Niue when publicly notified by the Resident Commissioner of Rarotonga in such manner as he thinks proper, in the Island of Niue when publicly notified by the Resident Commissioner of Niue in such manner as he thinks proper, and in the Mandated Territory of Western Samoa on the day of publication hereof in the Western Samoa Gazette.
- 4. The regulations made and enuring respectively under the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, the short titles of which are set out in the Schedule hereto, shall be in force in the Cook Islands and Western Samoa.
