ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 22nd day of May, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Cook Islands Act, 1915, and the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Dependency Emergency Regulations (No. 2) 1939, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Dependency Emergency Regulations (No. 2) 1939.\*
- 3. The Dependency Emergency Regulations (No. 2) 1939 shall apply to the regulations referred to in Regulation 5 hereof.
- 4. These regulations shall come into force in the Cook Islands other than Niue when publicly notified by the Resident Commissioner of Rarotonga in such manner as he thinks proper, in the Island of Niue when publicly notified by the Resident Commissioner of Niue in such manner as he thinks proper, and in the Mandated Territory of Western Samoa on the day of publication hereof in the Western Samoa Gazette.
- 5. The Finance Emergency Regulations 1940† made under the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, shall be in force in the Cook Islands and Western Samoa.
