THE DAIRY FACTORY MANAGERS REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 4

Pursuant to the Dairy Industry Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Factory Managers Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Factory Managers Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 12:11, and substituting the following regulation:—

"12:11. Any person appointed to be an examiner or to supervise an examination for the purposes of these regulations may be paid such fee, not exceeding £5 in respect of an examiner nor exceeding £2 2s. in respect of a supervisor, together with such travelling expenses, subsistence allowance, or other allowances while engaged on the business of an examiner or a supervisor as the Minister of Finance may approve:

"Provided that the fact that a person acts both as examiner and

as supervisor shall not entitle him to a greater fee than £5."

(2) Regulation 10 of the Dairy Factory Managers Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.
