ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of May 1982

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Factory Managers Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Factory Managers Regulations 1979\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase from \$5 to \$10 the fees for applications for registration, and renewal of registration, under the principal regulations, and from \$2.50 to \$5 the fees for notices of appeal and applications for duplicate certificates of registration.
