**THE DEER FARMING REGULATIONS 1969, AMENDMENT
NO. 1**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Deer Farming Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Deer Farming Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric amendment—Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “6 feet 6 inches”, and substituting the expression “2 m”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Deer Farming Regulations 1969 to show the minimum height of a perimeter fence of a deer farm in terms of metric units of measurement.
