PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Deer Farming Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Deer Farming Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

2. Licence fees—Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the words "Fifty dollars", and substituting the expression "\$100":
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the words "Twenty-five dollars", and substituting the expression "\$50".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fees for applications for a deer farming licence and for transfer of a deer farming licence from \$50 to \$100 and \$25 to \$50 respectively.
