## THE DAIRY FACTORY SUPPLY REGULATIONS, 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Date on which the regulations were made : 27th day of July, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette* : 29th day of July, 1937.

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, and for the purpose of giving effect to certain recommendations of the Commission of Inquiry referred to in the preamble to that Act and generally for the purpose of securing the effective conduct of the dairy industry, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Factory Supply Regulations, 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Dairy Factory Supply Regulations, 1936\* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 1937.

4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting next after clause 11 thereof the following additional clause :---

"11A. In any case where as a result of any determination of the Commission or in any case where by reason of clause 14 of the principal regulations it is necessary that all milk or cream from any supplying dairy shall be delivered to or collected by the owner of a manufacturing dairy (hereinafter in this clause termed "the transferee dairy") other than the owner of the manufacturing dairy (hereinafter in this clause termed "the transferor dairy") to or by whom such milk or cream has theretofore been delivered or collected and where any assignment or order made or given by the owner or occupier of such supplying dairy of or on moneys payable by the owner of the transferor dairy for milk or cream supplied by the owner of such supplying dairy is in full force and effect, then such assignment or order shall enure so as

to charge or affect according to the tenor thereof the moneys thereafter payable by the owner of the transferee dairy for milk or cream supplied by the owner or occupier of such supplying dairy as fully and effectually as if such assignment or order had been made or given of or on such last-mentioned moneys, and the owner of the transferee dairy may without further authority than this regulation make payment of such moneys in accordance with the terms of any such assignment or order."
