**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 17th day of April 1974

Present:

THE HON. H. WATT PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Factory Supply Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Factory Supply Regulations 1936\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Issue and transfer of certificates of registration or licence**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 9, and substituting the following regulation:

“9. The Director shall not issue any certificate of registration or licence or grant any transfer of a certificate of registration or of a licence to any person to use any premises as a manufacturing dairy, or as a dairy factory, without the prior consent in writing of the Board; but the Board’s consent shall not be required for the use of any premises solely for the manufacture of ice-cream, ice-cream mix, ice-cream base, yoghurt, cottage cheese, cream cheese or other soft short-life types of cheese, or other cultured or custard-type milk and cream product.”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Dairy Factory Supply Regulations 1936, and provide that the transfer of certificates of registration and licences shall, with certain exceptions, require the prior written consent of the New Zealand Dairy Board.
