**THE DANGEROUS GOODS (LICENSING AUTHORITIES)
REGULATIONS 1958, AMENDMENT NO. 6**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 8th day of March 1965

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Authorities) Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Authorities) Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1965.

2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from that portion of Part I of that Schedule that relates to City Councils the word "Dunedin":
- (b) By inserting in that portion of Part I of that Schedule that relates to County Councils (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Authorities) Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1), in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Grey" and "Manawatu":
- (c) By inserting in that portion of Part II of that Schedule that relates to City Councils, after the word "Christchurch", the word "Dunedin":
- (d) By inserting in that portion of Part II of that Schedule that relates to Borough Councils, after the word "Ellerslie", the word "Henderson".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is that—

- (a) The principal regulations will have effect as bylaws in the Counties of Grey and Manawatu and in the Borough of Henderson.
- (b) Dunedin City Council will receive the licence fees specified in regulation 10 of the principal regulations instead of those specified in regulation 9.
