



**THE DANGEROUS GOODS (LICENSING FEES) REGULATIONS
1976, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of July 1983

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 35 of the Dangerous Goods Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Fees) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Fees) Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. General exemptions—(1) Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (u), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(u) In quantities not exceeding—

“(i) 25 kg in all of dangerous goods of Class 4.1, Category A:

“(ii) 50 kg in all of dangerous goods of Class 4.1, Category B:

“(iii) 50 kg in all of dangerous goods of Class 4.2, Category A:

“(iv) 25 kg in all of dangerous goods of Class 4.3, Category C.”

(2) The said regulation 5 is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (v), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(v) Without limit as to quantity of any dangerous goods of Class 4.1, Category C, or Class 4.2, Category B or Category C, or Class 4.3, Category A or Category B:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations are consequential on the new schedule of Class 4 dangerous goods as substituted in the Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1974 by the Dangerous Goods Order 1983 (S.R. 1983/127).
