At the Government House at Greymouth this 29th day of March 1960

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1960.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, as amended by clause 2 of the Dangerous Goods Order 1959\*, is hereby further amended by inserting in that part of the Schedule that relates to County Councils, after the word "Waimea", the word "Wallace".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to declare the Wallace County Council to be a licensing authority for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957.
