Pursuant to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1962.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 is hereby amended by inserting in that part of the Schedule that relates to County Councils, after the word "Awatere", the words "Chatham Islands".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to constitute the Chatham Islands County Council a licensing authority for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957.
