ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 8th day of March 1965

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1965.
2. The Second Schedule of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 is hereby amended—
 - (a) By inserting in that part of that Schedule that relates to Borough Councils, after the word "Helensville", the word "Henderson":
 - (b) By inserting in that part of that Schedule that relates to County Councils, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Grey" and "Manawatu".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to constitute the following local authorities licensing authorities for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957:

The Henderson Borough Council
The Grey County Council
The Manawatu County Council.
