PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

- 1 This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1966.
2. The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 is hereby amended—
 - (a) By inserting in the part of that Schedule that relates to County Councils, after the word "Awatere", the word "Bruce":
 - (b) By omitting from the part of the Schedule that relates to Borough Councils the word "Naseby".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to constitute the Bruce County Council as a licensing authority for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 and to rescind the previous appointment of the Naseby Borough Council as a licensing authority.
