ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 13th day of March 1967

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1967.
2. The Second Schedule of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 (as amended by clause 2 of the Dangerous Goods Order 1959*) is hereby further amended by inserting in that part of that Schedule that relates to County Councils, after the word "Waimea", the word "Wairoa".
