## THE DANGEROUS GOODS ORDER 1969

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of March 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. **Title**—This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1969.

2. **Licensing authorities**—The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 is hereby amended—

- (a) By inserting in the part of that Schedule that relates to city councils, after the words "Lower Hutt", the word "Manukau":
- (b) By omitting from the part of that Schedule that relates to borough councils the words "Hampden", "Manurewa", "Palmerston", "Shannon", "Taradale", and "Waikouaiti":
- (c) By omitting from the part of that Schedule that relates to county councils the word "Manukau":
- (d) By omitting from the part of that Schedule that relates to county councils (as amended by clause 2 (b) of the Dangerous Goods Order 1964\*) the word "Murchison":
- (e) By inserting in the part of that Schedule that relates to county councils, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Matamata", "Taranaki", "Waikato", and "Waitemata":
- (f) By omitting from the part of that Schedule that relates to town councils the words "Leeston", "Lumsden", "Mangaweka", "Mercer", "Nightcaps", "Outram", and "Southbridge".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order—

- (a) Constitutes as licensing authorities for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, the Matamata, Taranaki, Waikato, and Waitemata County Councils;
- (b) Includes the Manukau City Council in the list of city councils that are licensing authorities and omits the Manukau County Council;
- (c) Omits the names of several local authorities whose districts have been merged in other districts.
