ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of March 1970

Pursuant to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1970.
- 2. Licensing Authorities—The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 is hereby amended by inserting in the part of that Schedule that relates to County Councils, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Buller", "Taieri", "Taupo", and "Waikouaiti".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. The effect of this order is to constitute the Buller, Taieri, Taupo, and Waikouaiti County Councils as Licensing Authorities for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957.
