ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 21st day of September, 1938.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Explosive and Dangerous Goods Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Dangerous Goods Regulations 1928* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 64 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking paragraphs (a), (b), (c), and (\overline{d}), and inserting in lieu thereof the following :—

(a) The Chief Inspector or a deputy appointed by him :

- (b) A representative of the Naval Board :
- (c) A representative of the Army Board :
- (d) A representative of the Air Department appointed by the Air Secretary :
- (e) The Harbour Engineer or other officer appointed by the Harbour Board concerned.
