PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1978.

2. Dairy produce grading levy abolished—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Part XIII.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1978, abolish the dairy produce grading levy.
