PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952 and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
