ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952 and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of the term “Director” the words “Director of the Dairy Division of the Ministry”, and substituting the expression “Director-General”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Dairy Industry Regulations 1977 to reflect the fact that there is no longer a Dairy Division of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, and that the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries performs the functions formerly performed by the Director of the Dairy Division.
