At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of July, 1946

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the several powers conferred on him in that behalf by the National Expenditure Adjustment Act, 1932, and its amendments, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Deposits Interest Restriction Order 1945, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. This Order shall be read with and form part of the Deposits Interest Restriction Order 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
- 3. This Order shall apply in the case of deposits received on or after the 1st day of July, 1946, by any building society or investment society.
- 4. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is amended by deleting the words and figures "Not less than 36 months $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in the last line of both columns thereof, and substituting the words and figures "Not less than 36 months $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".
- 5. Nothing herein shall be deemed to affect the maximum rate of interest that may be paid on any deposits already held by such a deposit-holding body on the said 1st day of July, 1946.
