

THE DAIRY-PRODUCE LEVY REGULATIONS 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy-produce Levy Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy-produce Levy Regulations 1936* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the first day of the month next following the month in which notification of the making of these regulations is published in the *Gazette*, and shall apply with respect to returns for the last-mentioned month and every subsequent

month.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking

clause 5 thereof, and substituting the following clause:

"5. (1) Every person, being a manufacturer of dairy-produce, shall furnish or cause to be furnished to the Department not later than seven days after the close of each month a return in accordance with a form to be provided by the Department giving the information referred to in the next succeeding subclause and such other information as the Department thinks fit concerning the stocks, manufacture, supplies, sales, and disposals of dairy-produce during the month preceding the date of the return. The return shall be certified as correct by writing thereon signed by the person making the return.

"(2) The return may be combined with the return required under clause 33 of the Butter Marketing Regulations 1937†, and shall, in respect of butter and also in respect of cheese, contain the information indicated in form No. 5 in the Second Schedule to those regulations."
