At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 21st day of March 1960

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy-Produce Levy Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy-Produce Levy Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:

"8. There shall from time to time be paid to the Board all money received by the Commission in respect of levies imposed under the authority of regulation 3 of these regulations:

"Provided that before any such money is paid to the Board there shall be deducted therefrom, and retained by the Commission in respect of the services of officers of the Commission, such percentage thereof, not exceeding 1 per cent, as shall from time to time be agreed upon by the Commission and the Board."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations empower the Dairy Board and the Dairy Products Marketing Commission to agree on the proportion of the dairy-produce levy to be deducted by the Commission for services in connection with the collection of the levy.
