PURSUANT to the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Reserve Bank of New Zealand, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the DFC New Zealand Limited (Appointment of Statutory Manager) Order 1990.
 (2) This order shall come into force on the 3rd day of April 1990.
- 2. Appointment of new statutory manager—Samford Lee Maier of Wellington, Banker, is hereby appointed as statutory manager of DFC New Zealand Limited and of every subsidiary of DFC New Zealand Limited, other than the subsidiaries specified in the Schedule to the DFC New Zealand Limited (Statutory Management) Order (No. 2) 1989, to take the place of Donald Leroy Francis and Thomas Hughes Lloyd Davies, both of

Wellington, Chartered Accountants.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order appoints Samford Lee Maier of Wellington, Banker, as statutory manager of DFC New Zealand Limited and its subsidiaries, other than the subsidiaries specified in the Schedule to the DFC New Zealand Limited (Statutory Management) Order (No. 2) 1989, in place of the present statutory managers.
