THE DERATTING OF SHIPS NOTICE 1961

PURSUANT to regulation 15 of the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957,* the Director-General of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Deratting of Ships Notice 1961.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1961.

2. For the purposes of the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957,* the ports listed in the First Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be ports approved for the purpose of the fumigation of ships, and for the purpose of the issue of deratting certificates.

3. For the purposes of the Quarantine (Ship) Regulations 1957,* the ports listed in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be ports approved for the purpose of the inspection of ships for traces of rodents, and for the purpose of the issue of deratting exemption certificates.

4. The Deratting of Ships Notice 1958† is hereby revoked.
