**THE DAIRY PRODUCE EXPORT CONTAINERS  
REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of December 1955

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Export Containers Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Export Containers Regulations 1950\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 12, the following regulation:

“12A. Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 12 of these regulations, it shall be lawful for the Board to accept any offer for the supply of butter boxes or to call tenders for the supply of butter boxes and for the Board to accept any such tender or tenders:

Provided that no offer or tender accepted shall be at a price in excess of the prices determined in accordance with regulation 12 of these regulations.”

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 13, the following regulation:

“13A. Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 13 of these regulations, it shall be lawful for the Board to accept any offer for the supply of cheese crates or to call for tenders for the supply of cheese crates and for the Board to accept any such tender or tenders:

“Provided that no offer or tender accepted shall be at a price in excess of the prices determined in accordance with regulation 13 of these regulations”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

The principal regulations provide that the prices to be paid for butter boxes and cheese crates are determined by a formula prescribed in the regulations. The amendments permit the Dairy Board to purchase butter boxes and cheese crates at prices below those fixed by the formula.
