PURSUANT to the Domestic Proceedings Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Domestic Proceedings (Marriage Guidance Organisations) Order 1969, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Domestic Proceedings (Marriage Guidance Organisations) Order 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Approved organisation—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by adding the words “Whangarei Marriage Guidance Council”.
