- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Domestic Proceedings (Marriage Guidance Organisations) Order 1969, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Domestic Proceedings (Marriage Guidance Organisations) Order 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- 2. Approved organisation—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "Southland Marriage Guidance Council", the words "Tauranga Family and Marriage Guidance Council".
