PURSUANT to the Domestic Proceedings Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Domestic Proceedings (Marriage Guidance Organisations) Order 1969, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Domestic Proceedings (Marriage Guidance Organisations) Order 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Approved organisations—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words “Auckland Marriage Guidance Centre” and “South Auckland Family and Marriage Guidance Council”.
