THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Products Marketing Commission Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Products Marketing Commission (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Products Marketing Commission (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "a subsistence allowance of £1 1s. for each half day", and substituting the words "a subsistence allowance of £1 7s. 6d. for each half day".

3. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"5. (1) Where a private motor car has been used by any member of the Commission or of any Committee appointed by the Commission the member shall be entitled to a mileage allowance, computed by the shortest possible practicable route, at the rate of 7d. a mile where the horsepower of the car does not exceed $9\frac{1}{2}$, $8\frac{1}{2}$ d. a mile where the horsepower of the car exceeds $9\frac{1}{2}$ but does not exceed $14\frac{1}{2}$, and $9\frac{1}{2}$ d. a mile where the horsepower of the car exceeds $14\frac{1}{2}$."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations provide for new rates of subsistence and mileage allowances payable to members of the Dairy Products Marketing Commission.
