**THE DAIRY PRODUCTS MARKETING COMMISSION
(TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1950,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Dairy Products Marketing Commission Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Products Marketing Commission (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Products Marketing Commission (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulations 3, 4, and 5, and substituting the following regulation:

“3. (1) Where any member of the Commission or of any Committee appointed by the Commission is required to be absent from his usual place of residence for the purpose of attending any meeting of the Commission or, with the approval of the Commission, of transacting any business of the Commission, there shall be paid to that member a subsistence allowance at such rate as the Minister of Finance from time to time approves in that behalf.

“(2) When the member, for any such purpose, is required to make any journey and he travels by public conveyance, there shall be paid to him all fares and other expenses of locomotion incurred by him in making the journey.

“(3) Where a private means of conveyance is used for any such journey there shall be paid to the member a milage allowance and garage expenses at such rates as the Minister of Finance from time to time approves in that behalf.”

(2) The Dairy Products Marketing Commission (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that rates of travelling allowances, milage allowances, and garage expenses of members of the Dairy Products Marketing Commission are to be those fixed by the Minister of Finance.
