AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 6th day of March 1961

Present:

THE HON. J. R. MARSHALL, PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (FAO) Order 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Diplomatic Privileges (FAO) Order 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Clause 11 of the principal order is hereby amended—

- (a) By inserting in subclause (1), after the words “member Governments” where they first occur, the words “(including Governments of associate members)”:
- (b) By inserting in subclause (1), after the words “member Governments” where they secondly occur, the words “(including associate members)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order extends to representatives of associate members of the Food and Agriculture Organisation of the United Nations the immunities and privileges that are accorded by the principal order to representatives of full members.
