**THE DAIRY PRODUCE REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT  
NO. 15**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of October 1957

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 15, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 30 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, before the word "Auckland" in subclause (1), the word "Opua".

(2) Regulation 30 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting, after the words "The Auckland Farmers' Freezing Co. Ltd. at" in subclause (2), the word "Moerewa".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations provide for the Port of Opua to be a port from which butter and cheese may be exported and appoint the premises of the Auckland Farmers' Freezing Company Limited at Moerewa as a grading store for export butter and cheese.
