THE DAIRY PRODUCE REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT NO. 17

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 17, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the

date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by

adding the following subclause:

"(19) Where, pursuant to section 7 (b) of the Dairy Industry Act 1952, an Inspector forbids absolutely the use of any milk can or cream can for the carriage or deposit of dairy produce, that Inspector shall, for the purpose of identifying the can as one the use of which in connection with dairy produce is absolutely prohibited, place on the interior rim or lip of the can, in a position immediately above one of the handles, a mark consisting of a double arrow, and the can shall not thereafter be used for the carriage or deposit of any dairy produce."
