ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of March 1962

Present:

THE HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 21, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Regulation 20 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) No person shall deliver, or cause to be delivered, to any manufacturing dairy, any milk or cream which—

“(a) Is affected by putrefactive decomposition; or

“(b) Contains or has contained any bird, maggot, rodent, or other animal; or

“(c) Contains any antibiotic or insecticide.”
