ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of May 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 31, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938*.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1976.

2. Dairy produce grading levy—(1) Regulation 8 of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3 (as amended by regulation 2 of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 30) is hereby further amended by revoking paragraphs (a) to (c), and substituting the following paragraphs:

“(a) In respect of butter, at a rate of 0.3272c per kilogram and computed on the total number of the kilograms of creamery butter and whey butter manufactured by the owner during any financial year as disclosed by the accounts and balance sheet of the owner for that year:

“(b) In respect of cheese, at a rate of 0.1527c per kilogram and computed on the total number of the kilograms of cheese manufactured by the owner during any financial year as disclosed by the accounts and balance sheet of the owner for that year:

“(c) In respect of anhydrous milkfat, at a rate of 0.0778c per kilogram and computed on the total number of the kilograms of anhydrous milkfat manufactured by the owner during any financial year as disclosed by the accounts and balance sheet of the owner for that year.”

(2) The Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 30, are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 June 1976, increase the dairy produce grading levies for butter, cheese, and anhydrous milkfat to 0.3272c, 0.1527c, and 0.0778c per kilogram respectively.
